# Union HRD Minister launches *Bharosa*, the CUO Helpline on Cognitive Emotional Rehabilitation Services for University Students of Odisha

In an historic and maiden effort to relieve the student community in distress during the troubled time of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Central University of Odisha organized the virtual launching Ceremony of *Bharosa* and its Helpline Number 08046801010. Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank, Union HRD Minister, launched the Helpline that aims at providing Cognitive Emotional Rehabilitation Services to all University Students of Odisha. Amongst the dignitaries present were Dr. Arun Kumar Sahoo, Hon'ble Minister, Dept of Higher Education, Government of Odisha, Shri Amit Khare, Secretary, Higher Education, MHRD, Shri Saswat Mishra, Commissioner cum Secretary, Government of Odisha, Shri Chandrasekhar Kumar, Joint Secretary, Higher Education, MHRD. The programme was coordinated by Prof I Ramabrahmam, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Odisha.

At the outset, the Vice Chancellor welcomed Dr Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank, the Union HRD Minister and other guests and highlighted the major features and services of the CUOs Helpline 'Bharosa' that seeks to address the problems of distressed students in the wake of COVID-19.
