SIGNING OF THE MoUs FOR ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT:

MoU with ICMR-NIRTH: CUO, Koraput signed a MoU with ICMR–National Institute of Research in Tribal Health (ICMR-NIRTH), Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh on 23 December 2021 for a period of five years.

Focus: Research collaboration on tribal health, nutrition and ethnomedicine along with training of students and faculty, faculty and scientist exchange, joint project supervision and research guidance.



MoU with CARD: CUO, Koraput signed a MoU with Centre for Adivasi Research and Development (CARD), Bhubaneswar, Odisha on 24th January 2022 for a period of five years.

Focus: Jointly undertaking projects and conducting, Conference/Symposia/Seminars towards awareness and empowerment of marginalised communities; promotion of diverse sets of skill based education; designing and offering cutting edge courses.



MoU with CSIR-IMMT: CUO signed a MoU with CSIR– Institute of Minerals and Materials Technology (CSIR-IMMT) on 31st January 2022 for a period of five years.

Focus : Collaborative research, and exchange of knowledge, technical knowhow and mentoring between the two institutions in areas such as Biological and Allied Sciences, Environmental Sciences and Engineering, Pharmaceutical Sciences and Technology, IPR and Innovation Management and Technology Development and Entrepreneurship etc.

CUO inks MoU with FIDR for tribal digital literacy centre

The Central University of Odisha (CUO), Koraput and the Forum for Integrated Development and Research (FIDR) India, Gurugram signed an MoU through online mode for next three years to collaborate on establishing a Digital Tribal Literacy Centre for the tribal youth of Odisha.

Dr. Asit Kumar Das, Registrar, CUO and Mr. Debi Patnaik from FIDR signed

the MoU in the presence of Prof. S. K. Palita, Vice-Chancellor In-charge, CUO and Charudatta Panigrahi, Director, FIDR.

Prof. Palita said "the Central University is going to provide digital literacy to the tribal students and other students of the marginalized community of this region with the support of FIDR. The establishment of the Centre will open opportunity of digital skills to boys and girls of the marginalized com-

munities which in course of time make them self-employed".

Expressing happiness, Charudatta Panigrahi, Director, FIDR said "The establishment of the Centre will fulfill long required soft skill education of the region and will boost economic empowerment of youth".

Registrar Dr. Asit Kumar Das said the CUO will do its best to establish the Digital Tribal Literacy Centre as soon as possible.

MoU with HAL, Sunabeda: Central University of Odisha has signed MoU with Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL), Sunabeda, a leading Navaratna PSU, for promoting academics, research and regional development through partnership. Under this programme, 'Distinguished Lecture Series' have been initiated, and as such many by persons of eminence from various fields of Science, Technology, Literature, Humanities and Management, etc. have been invited to the University for academic enrichment.

MoU with PHDMA: Central University of Odisha signed MoU with Poverty & Human Development Monitoring Agency (PHDMA), Bhubaneswar, Planning & Convergence Department, Government of Odisha. Under this MoU, PHDMA has introduced Odisha Development Fellow (ODEV Fellow), and provides a platform for the students and academics to substantially contribute in impact analysis and documentation of poverty reduction measures, innovative initiatives in securing livelihood and overall economic empowerment of people. The fellows will be partners in scripting the transformation story of Odisha. Sectors like agriculture and allied activities, skill training, livelihood, water harvesting, irrigation, penetration of health facilities are to be taken up for evidence-based analysis. The report of such studies would evaluate the output of the multifarious schemes taken up by the Odisha government.

MoU for establishment of DACE: CUO signed a MoU with Dr. Ambedkar Foundation, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, GOI along with 30 other Central Universities for establishment of Dr. Ambedkar Centre for Excellence (DACE) on 22nd April 2022 at BHU. Focus: DACE aims to provide free UPSC exam coaching for 100 Scheduled Caste (SC) students, of which 30% should be girls. With this launch, the government aims to achieve the social justice goal by providing inclusive opportunities.



Dr. Ambedkar Centre of Excellence (DACE): As per the directive of the Ambedkar Foundation DACE programme has been launched for the session 2022-23.

- An Advisory Body has been formed with persons of repute to monitor the activities and functioning of DACE.
- Advertisement for appointment of Coordinator was made, followed by screening of applications and interview for selection of Coordinator has been completed.
- Application on all India basis has been invited for admission of Sc candidates into DACE programme has been done through SAMARH, New Delhi. The Admission process is to be continued.

Community Based Participatory Research (CBPR) programme at the University as Regional Centre in Eastern Region (UGC Funded)

- A three-day Master Trainers' Training programme was organised by CUO as UGC Regional Centre for Eastern Region to train the MTs under Community Based Participatory Research (CBPR) methodology.
- The workshop was held from 7th to 9th June 2022 where 32 MTs from across 5 states of Eastern India – Odisha, Sikkim, Bihar, Jharkhand, and West Bengal - participated.
- Dr. Rajesh Tandon (UNESCO Chair on Community Based Research and Social Responsibility in Higher Education; Founder President, PRIA, New Delhi), Mr. Binoy Acharya (Founder Director, UNNATI, Ahmedabad), and Mr. Jagadananda (Mentor & Co-Founder, Centre for Youth and Social Development) were the facilitators for the training workshop.
- For field visits, three NGOs namely Pragati, Dhan Foundation and Foundation for Ecological Security (FES) supported as facilitators for community based participation.
- Dr. Ramendra Kumar Parhi, DSW (I/c) of the University was the Regional Coordinator.



- The Faculty members, Dr. Jayanta Kumar Nayak, and Dr. Minati Sahoo were participants-cum-Field facilitators, whereas Dr. Kapila Khemundu and Dr. Debabrata Panda were facilitators for field visits.

Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) Programme under the “Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav” Week from February 24- March 15, 2022 (Flagship Programme of the Ministry)

- The CUO and Mahatma Gandhi Antarrashtriya Hindi Viswavidyalaya (MAHV), Wardha jointly organized the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat under the “Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav” Week from February 24- March 15, 2022 as per the directive of the Ministry of Education, Government of India.
- Under this program, the students of both Universities were engaged in exercises like Webinar, Film Festival, Cultural Performance and Video making on places of historical importance in blended mode as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Education.
- On this occasion, students from both the Universities celebrated the Valedictory Session of the programme with a Webinar on “My State: My Culture” on 15th March 2022. Prof. Kailash Pattanaik, former Head and Professor, Department of Odia, Vishva Bharti, Shantiniketan was the Resource Person.
- Vice Chancellor of both Universities, Prof. Rajnis Shukla of MAHV and Prof. S.K. Palita spoke on the importance of EBSB for highlighting culture.
- Dr Sourav Gupta, the Nodal Officer, EBSB, CUO coordinated the total programme.



Tribal Digital Literacy Programme Launched:

- To focus on digital skills and literacy among tribal youth, the Central University of Odisha launched Tribal Digital Literacy programme on 12th August at its Campus in collaboration with FIDR, Bhubaneswar.
- The Centre will be operative at the Centre for Tribal Welfare and Community Development (CTWCD) of the University at Koraput to train the youth belonging to ST, SC, OBC, and other marginalised communities of the Koraput district on digital skills.
- The programme was inaugurated by VC (I/c), Prof. S.K. Palita, Dr. Charudatt Panigrahi, Founder Mentor, FIDR, Dr. Guha Poonam, Director, ST, Odisha, Shri Raghuram Padal, Hon'ble MLA, Koraput and Shri Sushil Kumar Padhy, ED, NALCO were present.



- Dr. Kapila Khemundu, Head I/c Sociology is the Coordinator of the programme.
- The Advertisement for selection of the students and Trainer has been issued.

Green Energy initiative: Roof-top solar panel installation

- As an initiative for using green energy, the University has issued work order to CPWD (vide letter ref. No. CUO/XXXI-93/2022/268 dated 30.03.2022) for installing roof-top solar panels at an estimated cost of Rs. 72, 10,500/- and 1/3rd payment of Rs. 24, 03,500/- has also released on dt. 31.03.2022.

Green Campus: Plantation drive with 10,000 (ten thousands) saplings

- As a commitment to increase greenery in the campus, the University took up a massive plantation drive with 10, 000 (Ten Thousand) ornamental, medicinal saplings in collaboration with the Koraput Forest Dept.
- The plantation process started with 73rd Vana Mahotsav. The saplings have been successfully planted and barbed fencing wire encircled for protection of saplings.
