## Central University of Odisha pays tribute to Bharat Ratna Dr. B. R. Ambedkar

The Central University of Odisha paid homage and floral tributes to Bharat Ratna Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, the architect of the Constitution of India on his Mahaparinirvana Diwas, i.e. on his 64<sup>th</sup> Death Anniversary. On the occasion, Prof. I. Ramabrahmam, Vice-Chancellor addressed the University community and highlighted some of the great contribution of Ambedkar to our nation.
