NOTICE

For convenience of interested candidates, it is decided with immediate effect that -

- A. The candidates whose result is not declared yet may also apply online for admission to various UG/PG/5-year Integrated M.Sc. and Research Programmes offered by the University. The candidates need to upload/update aggregate percentage of marks of qualifying examination upto last date of online admission registration form submission of CUO, Odisha by using registered e-mail ID and password.
 - The candidates who shall not upload/update their percentage of marks of the qualifying examination till the last date of online admission registration form submission at online Admission –Portal of CUO, Odisha due to any reason, whatsoever, shall not be eligible for admission under any circumstances and there shall be no refund of registration fee.
- B. The candidates are required to submit/upload the Affidavit in prescribed format on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 20. Now, the candidates may either submit/upload it at the time of online admission registration form submission OR submit it at the time of counselling/admission.
- C. To clarify the issues related with the Scheduled Areas in Odisha, it is pertinent to mention that in exercise of powers conferred by sub-paragraph 6 of the Fifth Schedule to the Constitution of India, the revised Presidential Order titled "The Scheduled Areas (states of Bihar, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh & Odisha) Order 1977" has declared the full districts viz. Mayurbhanj, Sundargarh, Koraput (which now includes the districts of Koraput, Malkangiri, Nabarangapur and Rayagada), Kuchinda tahasil of Sambalpur district, Keonjhar, Telkoi, Champua, Barbil tahasils of Keonjhar district, Khondamal, Balliguda and G.Udayagiri tahasil of Khondamal district, R.Udaygiri tahasil, Gumma and Rayagada block of Parlekhemundi tahasil in Parlakhemundi Sub-division and Suruda tahasil (excluding Gazalbadi and Gochha Gram Panchayats), of Ghumsur sub-division in Ganjam district, Thuamul Rampur and Lanjigarh blocks of Kalahandi district and Nilagiri block of Balasore district as Scheduled Areas of the state. After reorganisation of districts in the Odisha state, 7 districts fully and 6 districts partly are covered under the Scheduled Areas of the state.
- D. Schedule of Admissions as given in CUO Prospectus 2021-22 shall be revised and uploaded on CUO website at the time of declaration of admission merit lists.
