3rd ROUND (FINAL ROUND) SPOT ADMISSION NOTICE 2025-26

The Central University of Odisha, in adherence to its policy of inclusive education and in accordance with the applicable provisions governing admissions to central universities, hereby notifies that a Spot Admission process shall be conducted on **26**th **August, 2025 for** filling up the vacant seats in various academic programmes offered by the University under both reserved and unreserved categories. It is hereby informed that all interested candidates, irrespective of whether they appeared in the CUET-PG 2025 examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), shall be eligible to participate in the said Spot Admission, subject to fulfillment of the minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed by the University for the respective programmes. Admission shall be granted strictly in accordance with the merit and availability of seats, and in compliance with the reservation policy of the Government of India.

- 1. All interested candidates are required to report from 9.30 AM to 10:30 AM on the 26th August, 2025.
- 2. The application-cum-counselling fee shall be ₹1000/- (non-refundable) for all categories and shall be payable online through SBI Collect at the time of reporting for Spot Admission.
- 3. Admission shall be granted strictly on the basis of the **percentage score** obtained in the **Spot Entrance Test** to be conducted on the same day.
- 4. Candidates are mandatorily required to carry all relevant original documents, along with one set of self-attested photocopies, and five recent passport size photographs, as prescribed in the **University Prospectus 2025–2026**.
- 5. Document verification shall be conducted from **10:30 AM to 11:30 AM** in the respective departments at the Central University of Odisha, NAD Sunabeda, Dist Koraput.
- 6. Only those candidates who are found eligible upon successful verification of documents shall be permitted to appear in the Spot Entrance Test, which shall be conducted from 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM. The test shall consist of 25 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), carrying a maximum of 50 marks, and shall follow a no negative marking policy for incorrect or un-attempted answers. The entrance test syllabus shall be based on the relevant undergraduate curriculum for all postgraduate programmes, except for MBA (Logistics and Supply Chain Management), M.A. in Journalism & Mass Communication, M.A. in Sociology, for which the syllabus shall comprise General Knowledge topics and for M.Sc. in BCNR, the entrance test syllabus shall be based on the relevant undergraduate curriculum for Life Science/Earth Science/Environmental Science. The results of the entrance test shall be announced by 2:30 PM, and admissions shall commence immediately thereafter. Payment of the admission fee shall also be made online through SBI Collect.
- 7. It is hereby clarified that the University provides no assurance of admission to any candidate unless he or she is physically present for document verification and participates in the entrance test. All candidates are therefore required to report for admission at their own responsibility and interest. Furthermore, the number of vacant seats may be subject to change, including possible increases due to subsequent cancellations or reallocation of categories.
- 8. A candidate belonging to a reserved category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS) is eligible to appear in both the Unreserved (UR) merit list and their respective reserved category list. If the candidate is not admitted under a UR seat but secures admission under their reserved category in any round, they may still be upgraded to a UR seat in a subsequent round, provided their merit is high enough. Under all circumstances, the UR cut-off must always be equal to or higher than the cut-off for any reserved category, ensuring the integrity of the merit system. As a result, while preparing



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subsequent merit lists, the number of vacancies in the UR category may decrease due to the upgradation of high-merit reserved category candidates, and the corresponding number of vacancies in the reserved categories may increase. If the list of eligible candidates in the OBC-NCL or EWS category is exhausted, any vacant seats in such categories shall be converted to Unreserved (UR) category seats. In the event of exhaustion of eligible candidates in either SC or ST categories, vacant seats may be filled by mutual interchange between SC and ST categories, subject to applicable regulations.

9. The Spot Admission 2025-26 will be conducted for admission in following programmes:

12. All shortlisted/admitted candidates shall mandatorily submit the **final mark sheet or certificate** of their qualifying examination **within thirty (30) days** from the date of admission. **Failure to submit** the requisite document(s) within the prescribed timeframe shall result in **automatic cancellation of admission without any prior notice**, and the University shall not entertain any request for extension or reconsideration under any circumstances. Furthermore, in cases where the submitted final mark sheet reveals that the candidate **has not secured the minimum percentage of marks or grade** required for eligibility to the respective programme as prescribed by the University, such admission shall stand **automatically cancelled**, irrespective of the stage of admission or attendance. The



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University reserves the right to withdraw such admissions forthwith and offer the seat to the next eligible candidate as per merit.

- 13. If a candidate fails to submit the required documents or category certificate (if applicable), or fails to pay the admission fee within the prescribed timeline, the allotted seat will be automatically forfeited without any further notice. Such seats shall be made available for the next round of admission.
- 14. In case of vacancy, further merit lists may be displayed on the official website of the Central University of Odisha. Candidates are advised to regularly visit the University website for updates and instructions.
- 15. The University reserves the right to subject any admitted candidate to a **medical fitness examination** conducted by the **University Medical Officer or a designated medical authority**. Admission shall be confirmed only upon certification of medical fitness by such authority.
- 16. Candidates whose **qualifying examination is not recognized** by UGC, or any other statutory authority shall be deemed **ineligible for admission**, and their application or admission shall be cancelled forthwith, irrespective of the stage at which the discrepancy is discovered.
- 17. Candidates who are in service and are selected for admission to any **full-time programme** must submit a **relieving order or sanctioned leave certificate** from their employer at the time of physical document verification. Failure to produce such a document shall result in **automatic withdrawal of the admission offer**.
- 18. The hostel seats are currently not available. Accordingly, hostel accommodation shall not be guaranteed to candidates participating in the 3rd Round Spot Admission. However, in the event that vacancies arise at a later stage, hostel accommodation may be considered, subject to availability and in accordance with the prevailing university policy.
- 19. In all matters of admission, including disputes and unforeseen circumstances, the decision of the University shall be final and binding. Any form of canvassing or malpractice shall result in disqualification and cancellation of candidature.
- 20. The refund of fees, where applicable, shall be governed by the UGC Guidelines in force at the time of withdrawal/cancellation.
- 21. In the event of any ambiguity or contradiction between the above instructions and the provisions stipulated in the Prospectus 2025–2026, the statements and regulations contained in the Prospectus shall prevail and be deemed final for all purposes.
- 22. All legal disputes pertaining to the admission process shall fall under the jurisdiction of courts located in Koraput, Odisha only.
